

The decision taken by PEC 114th EAB meeting for engineering programs of NUST – Military College of Signals, Rawalpindi is reproduced below:

B.E. Electrical (Re-accr.)	<p>Based on the satisfactory level of compliance and triangulation of breadth and depth of the program, QMS, CQI and implementation of OBE system, the <u>re-accreditation is granted for four (04) years of Intake Batches 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023.</u></p> <p>The HEI is required to submit a Midterm Progress Report as part of CQI process along with the evidence/ record on initiatives, major chances, accomplishments, and attainments, after the graduation of Intake batch 2022.</p> <p>The Institution, however, is required to address all observations, particularly in Criteria-3, as mentioned in the evaluation report as part of its CQI process before applying for re-accreditation.</p>
B.E. Information Security (Accreditation)	<p>Based on the satisfactory level of compliance and triangulation of breadth and depth of the program, QMS, CQI and implementation of OBE system, the <u>accreditation is granted for two (02) years of Intake Batches 2020 and 2021.</u></p> <p>The Institution, however, is required to address all observations, particularly in Criteria-2, 3 & 8 as mentioned in the evaluation report as part of its CQI process before applying for re-accreditation.</p>
B.E. Software (Re-accr.)	<p>Based on the satisfactory level of compliance and triangulation of breadth and depth of the program, QMS, CQI and implementation of OBE system, the <u>re-accreditation is granted for three (03) years of Intake Batches 2020, 2021 and 2022.</u></p> <p>The Institution, however, is required to address all observations, particularly in Criteria-2, as mentioned in the evaluation report as part of its CQI process before applying for re-accreditation.</p>

Note: It is to inform that EAB has now discontinued to mention the Level-II, understanding thereby that all such programs are now accredited on Level-II (substantially equivalent to WA programs), unless particularly mentioned otherwise.
