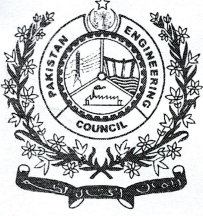

The Institution, however, is required to address all weaknesses & concerns particularly in Criteria 2, 3, and 6 as mentioned in the visit report as part of its CQI process before applying for re-accreditation.
