The decision taken by PEC 114th EAB meeting for following engineering program of NUST-School of Chemical & Materials Engineering (SCME) is reproduced below:

Engineering Program / Visit Type	Decision
Bachelor of Metallurgy and Materials Engineering (SCME) (Re-Accreditation)	Based on the satisfactory level of compliance and triangulation of breadth and depth of the program, QMS, CQI and implementation of OBE system, re-accreditation is granted for three (03) years i.e. Intake Batches 2020, 2021 & 2022. The Institution, however, is required to address all observations of the evaluation report, particularly in Criteria-4, 5 & 8 as part of CQI process before applying for reaccreditation.

Note: It is to inform that EAB has now discontinued to mention the Level-II, understanding thereby that all such programs are now accredited on Level-II (substantially equivalent to WA programs), unless particularly mentioned it otherwise.
